No previous experience or special skills required.

Safety is our priority. On-site training is given to all new volunteers on the safety of themselves and others.

If you would like to become a RPSI volunteer then you **must**:

- Be an RPSI Member (required for insurance purposes).
- Complete a self-certification form (to ensure eligibility for volunteering).
- If a vulnerable adult, be accompanied by a guardian or family member to take responsibility at all times.
- Be aged over 18. Exceptions are:
 - 14+, accompanied by a parent, guardian or family member to take responsibility at all times (Whitehead).
 - 16+, accompanied by a letter of parental releases (Whitehead).
 - In the Dublin area, off-train work is done on railway property and under-18s or vulnerable adults are not permitted, even for a visit.
